Your Role

- Supporting logistics of the days themselves
- Supporting logistics of participants being in College
- Supporting entertainment and refreshments in the JCR social evenings
- Being a primary point of contact for participants queries
- Supporting the Access Officer in supervising participants when necessary.
- Supporting the Access Officer with any other reasonable elements of the days.

Ambassadors are essential to support a smooth set of events. These events have many different elements, with many happening simultaneously. A committed, competent, and supportive team is essential to successful event delivery.

Your Commitment

Firstly you may specify, in the application form, which events you wish to be considered for:

- North East Access Residential – Tues 1st July
- Summer Study Days – Sun 10th August - Sat 16th August
- NextGen Y13 Residential – Thurs 18th September

Accommodation in College will be available for the night before and until the morning after, each event.

You will also need to attend a compulsory briefing session, which will be scheduled before the end of term, which you will be paid.

Pay and Particulars

College pay the hourly Living Wage. We offer accommodation for the duration of the events, in College, this may not be your current room. We also provide meals for free.
